

MPCAC Annual Report July 2020-June 2021

The MPCAC Board meets regularly, once each month, to review, discuss, and make decisions regarding accreditation and re-accreditation for qualified program applicants. The basis for these decisions is Site Visit Reports provided by the relevant Accreditation Review Committee (ARC) plus two additional reviewers. The Executive Committee meets weekly to keep abreast of the status of applications, to monitor the work of the ARCs, and to identify and make recommendations regarding policy and procedural issues that may emerge. Such issues are brought to the Board meetings for discussion and resolution. The Board functions as a 'working board' with members involved in all aspects of the work of MPCAC; efforts are slowly underway to move the operational work of the Board to the Central Office, a move which will require the addition of staff to the Central Office.

The most recent *Accreditation Manual* and *Policy & Procedure Manual* are available on the MPCAC website (<u>www.mpcacaccreditation.org</u>). The MPCAC standards, detailed in the *Accreditation Manual*, will be reviewed in 2022 for potential revisions in 2023.

<u>CHEA</u>

As of May 3, 2021, we were most pleased that CHEA awarded MPCAC recognition for a period of seven (7) years. The multi-phase recognition process included an extensive self-study report, permitting CHEA Board members to review our processes to confirm that we meet all CHEA standards, an observation of our decision-making, and a presentation and question-and-answer meeting with CHEA Board members. The first observation of our decision-making discussion was in February 2020; however, our observer became ill and was unable to provide the necessary report to CHEA. Subsequently, we had a second such observation in August 2020. The MPCAC presentation and Q&A with the CHEA Committee on Recognition occurred in November and the final CHEA decision was communicated to MPCAC in May, 2021.

<u>ASPA</u>

MPCAC continues its membership in the Association of Specialized and Professional Accreditors (ASPA). ASPA is dedicated to enhancing quality in higher education through specialized and professional accreditation and comprises organizations that evaluate programs and institutions of higher learning in more than 100 different specialized disciplines and professions. MPCAC remains an active member of ASPA and our Executive Director, Dr. Pat O'Connor, participates regularly in ASPA-sponsored webinars and attended the ASPA meeting held virtually in March.

Fee Structure

The application fee for new programs seeking accreditation and accredited programs seeking reaccreditation remains \$2,500; and the yearly maintenance fee also remains \$500. The penalty for late dues payment is the same at \$200. The COVID-related pandemic resulted in our shifting entirely to virtual site visits with a site-visit-fee of \$1000; the virtual site visit eliminates all onsite costs for the applicant programs.

Annual Reporting Requirements

MPCAC has an annual reporting structure which is common for many CHEA recognized bodies. This yearly report includes metrics such as number of applications, number of students enrolled, number of faculty members (including gender, race/ethnicity), retention rates including the retention rate of first year students, number of graduates in the current year, graduation rates for each entering class five years previously, and alumni information. Accredited programs are required to report these data to MPCAC every fall, and to post them on their institution's websites. Failure to report (or to pay the annual fee) may result in a warning, then probation, then withdrawal of accreditation. At this point no such instances have occurred.

Accredited programs are required to update MPCAC on other major changes affecting the program within THREE MONTHS of the change or at the time of the submission of the annual program data.

Board Membership

In summer 2020, MPCAC welcomed one new member to the MPCAC Board, who began her term in July 2020:

Jane Stafford (Chair), Mark Kenney (Associate Chair of Information Management), Genelle Sawyer (Associate Chair of Accreditation), and Brooks Wright (Treasurer) continue to serve in their respective roles, together with Pat O'Connor, MPCAC's Executive Director, and Kim Yetto, Executive Assistant. Chris Walter agreed to serve as Secretary beginning in September of 2019. Jennifer Gafford, Kristy Keefe, Maureen Keeshin, Erica James, and Celeste Jean-Walley also continue to serve as members on the MPCAC Board.

Current Status of Accreditations

As of June 2021, 58 applied masters programs from 50 institutions across 23 States were accredited by MPCAC. In 2020-2021, 2 programs were newly accredited and 2 received re-accreditation; one institution eliminated or suspended their master's program because they moved to a PsyD program, and a previously accredited program in another institution was denied accreditation. Several are currently under ongoing review to determine whether identified stipulations have been met (permitted for accreditations awarded prior to 2018).
