

MPCAC Standard Change: 60-credit Requirement

MPCAC-accredited programs must be the equivalent of at least two academic years of full-time study and 60 credits (or the equivalent quarter credits), which must include the supervised experience as described in #3 below. The timeline for all programs to meet the 60 credit requirement is as follows:

- June 2024: The program plan for a 60 credit degree has received the appropriate (state, institutional, departmental, etc.) curricular approvals
- September 2025: The approved 60 credit degree is fully implemented with the necessary additional resources (increased faculty, classrooms, other teaching spaces, etc.).
