MPCAC Standard Change: 60-credit Requirement

MPCAC-accredited programs must be the equivalent of at least two academic years of fulltime study and 60 credits (or the equivalent quarter credits), which must include the supervised experience as described in #3 below. The timeline for all programs to meet the 60 credit requirement is as follows:

• June 2024: The program plan for a 60 credit degree has received the appropriate (state, institutional, departmental, etc.) curricular approvals

• September 2025: The approved 60 credit degree is fully implemented with the necessary additional resources (increased faculty, classrooms, other teaching spaces, etc.).
